Main Events

The events listed below are only the largest events that have become traditions in the ABACUS social calendar. Funkyard

Date: Second week of October

Venue: Varies (Held at Revolution, Cambridge last year)

Attendees: 500 including ABACUS members, other Cambridge oriental society members, the local Chinese community and language students.

The biggest Oriental clubbing night in Cambridge; this is a hugely-popular event, attended by students and locals alike. The event is organized and promoted solely by ABACUS, and allows new students to socialise with each other and make new friends from across the entire university. This event provides a perfect opportunity to promote your business to the new intake of students at Cambridge, through our facebook, tickets, and posters.

Boat Party

Date: Mid November

Venue: River Thames, London

Attendees: 300-500

This is the largest and most popular ABACUS event of the year. The event is hosted in collaboration with our sister society, Asia Pacific Society, located in Oxford. It allows students nationwide to meet in a glamorous setting against the backdrop of the River Thames at night, and is sure to widen knowledge of your business, again through our facebook, tickets, and posters.

Chinese New Year Party

Date: The Week of Chinese New Year

Venue: Varies (Held at The Cambridge Union last year)

Attendees: 100-200

This is one of our more cultural events, with ABACUS aspiring to give a modern twist to traditional Chinese New Year celebrations. We provide a relaxed party atmosphere for our members to chat, eat and reflect on the year just gone. This is always an extremely popular event, attracting a very broad range of members.

Garden Party

Date: Mid June

Venue: Fellows' Garden, St. John's College.

Attendees: 70-100

This is the final ABACUS event of the academic year, and there is typically a big turnout, as students come to celebrate the end of exams and bid their friends in their last year farewell. There is plenty of food and drinks as well as live entertainment. Traditionally, we have been provided food and beverages through sponsors in the catering industry.
